The Big Stone County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. Chairman Sandberg called the meeting to order with Commissioners Athey, Olson, and Klages present. Commissioner Zimmel was absent. Also present were Dillon Dwyer of the Ortonville Independent and Coordinator Pam Rud. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Motion by Athey, seconded by Olson and carried unanimously to approve the hiring of Rebecca Trapp as the County Attorney. Trapp will begin with the County on April 1st with an annual salary of \$137,571.20.

Motion by Olson, seconded by Athey and carried unanimously to send a letter of support to the Department of Employment and Economic Development for the Childcare Economic Development Grant that is being submitted by the Upper Minnesota Valley Regional Development Commission in coordination with the Southwest Initiative Foundation and Prairie Five.
