SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BIG STONE COUNTY BOARD September 4, 2019

The Big Stone County Board of Commissioners were invited to meet with the Organizational Structure Committee on September 4, 2019, at 12:30 PM in the Family Services Conference Room to provide input to the Committee and share their individual visions regarding a revised organizational structure so the Committee can continue moving forward with their role in the process.

Commissioners Athey, Backer, Klepel and Sandberg were present. Also present were Jim Mulder and committee members Assessor Sandy Vold, Recorder Elaine Martig, Family Services Director Pam Rud, Social Services Supervisor Amy Weir, Environmental Director Darren Wilke, County Engineer Todd Larson and Auditor Michelle Knutson.

As a working meeting, no decisions were made. Any decisions will be handled by the Commissioners at a County Board meeting. Discussion was held on a possible timeline for implementation of this proposed organizational structure. There was general agreement that the board is very interested in pursuing this change unless something of significance would occur that would result in reevaluating the proposed structure. Consensus was that the Committee would proceed with finalizing a County Coordinator job description with possible recruitment to begin the fall of 2020 for a 2021 start date, with the understanding that circumstances may change and that the timeline needs to remain flexible.
